



2020 TAYLOR HAUGEN SCHOLARSHIP

The \$1,500 scholarships are offered in the memory of Taylor Reid Haugen, Class of 2011. Taylor was a member of the Niceville Eagles Football and Wrestling Teams as well as being an Honor Student at Niceville High School. He was comfortably expressive about his faith in God and showed it through his commitment to volunteer work in his church and community. This scholarship is awarded to an area athlete who best demonstrates a similar balance between academics, athleticism, leadership, community service and Christian faith. The Foundation hopes to recognize those well-rounded individuals who demonstrate the perseverance to improve themselves in all aspects of their life while enjoying God's gifts to the fullest.

Eligibility Requirements:

- ❖ Applicant must be a senior at an Okaloosa, Santa Rosa, Bay or Walton county high school;
- ❖ Applicant must be an athlete who has participated in a high school sport as defined by the FHSAA;
- ❖ Applicant must have a minimum 3.5 GPA unweighted; and 4.0 GPA weighted.
- ❖ Applicant must be an active participant in community service;
- ❖ Applicant may not be a family member of a Taylor Haugen Foundation executive committee nor any of its scholarship judges.
- ❖ Applicant must be planning to attend a four-year accredited college.
- ❖ Trophy nominees are eligible for scholarship for their respective counties if they meet all requirements;
- ❖ Note: Due to NCAA eligibility requirements, recipients of full college athletic scholarships are not eligible to receive the \$1,500 scholarship from the Foundation.

THE TAYLOR HAUGEN SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

Candidates must be a high school, senior class, athlete who embodies and represents the criteria established below

- Minimum 3.5 Unweighted GPA and 4.0 Weighted GPA
- Focused On Higher Education/Receiving Degree
- Must Be A Graduating Senior In High School

ATHLETIC

20%

- All FHSAA Sports/Athletes Considered. Above Average Team Spirit/Motivated/Inspires Others. Participation In More Than One Sport Is A Positive.
- Accountable And Dependable To The Team/ Always Gives 100%/Consistently Puts Forth The Extra Effort
- Measurable And Significant Athletic Improvement And Achievement Over Time. Demonstrates Extra Effort To Improve Skills In Their Sport And Is Passionate About Their Sport

COMMUNITY SERVICE

20%

- Measurable Areas Of Volunteering To Assist Others/Events/Activities And Is Actively Involved In Other Extra Curricular Activities
- Recognized Leadership And Consistent Participation
- Active Community Service Outside School Sanctioned Activities.

CHRISTIAN FAITH

20%

- Exhibits Living Faith By Compassionate Service To Community, Church And Organizations That Is Consistent, Sustained And Selfless
- Professes Beliefs Within Daily Activities Through Loving Acts And Godly Characteristics.

Instructions/Checklist for completing application:

1. Please type or print clearly.
2. Application is to be completed by applicant. Entire Application should be scanned and **submitted electronically** to director@taylorhaugen.org.
3. Include a maximum of TWO letters of recommendation from people other than relatives. One must be academically based from a school official: teacher, coach, counselor, and/or principal. The second letter must be a recommendation based on your moral character. Letters may not be from Taylor Haugen Foundation Board member.
4. Submit Senior resume highlighting all activities, athletics and awards.
5. Include Academic Record Guidance form with signed verification
6. Complete and submit the Statement of Understanding signed by the student and his/her parent, guardian, or sponsor
7. Include answers to 4 short response areas (150 words or less each)
8. Include a personal 300 – 500 word essay on the following topic
 - Tell us about a life experience where you have had difficulty and have had to persevere and not give up.
9. Applicant may be contacted for an interview with the scholarship committee at a date to be determined.

Note: Incomplete applications will not be considered.
