

The \$1,500 scholarships are offered in the memory of Taylor Reid Haugen, Class of 2011. Taylor was a member of the Niceville Eagles Football and Wrestling Teams as well as being an Honor Student at Niceville High School. He was comfortably expressive about his faith in God and showed it through his commitment to volunteer work in his church and community. This scholarship is awarded to an area athlete who best demonstrates a similar balance between Academics, Athleticism, Leadership, Community Service and Christian Faith. The Foundation hopes to recognize those well-rounded individuals who demonstrate the perseverance to improve themselves in all aspects of their life while enjoying God's gifts to the fullest.

! Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicant must be a senior at an Okaloosa, Santa Rosa, Bay or Walton County high school;
- Applicant must be an athlete who has participated in a high school sport as defined by the FHSAA;
- ❖ Applicant must have a minimum 3.5 GPA unweighted; and 4.0 GPA weighted;
- ❖ Applicant must be an active participant in community service;
- ❖ Applicant may not be a family member of a Taylor Haugen Foundation Executive Committee nor any of its scholarship judges;
- ❖ Applicant must be planning to attend a four-year accredited college;
- Trophy nominees are eligible for scholarship for their respective counties if they meet all requirements;
- Note: Due to NCAA eligibility requirements, recipients of full college athletic scholarships are not eligible to receive the \$1,500 scholarship from the Foundation.

TAYLOR HAUGEN FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

- Measurable And Significant Athletic Improvement And Achievement Over Time.
 Demonstrates Extra Effort To Improve Skills In Their Sport And Is Passionate About Their Sport

- 2. Application must be **Typed**. **No Handwritten**.
- 3. Application must be scanned & submitted electronically in a PDF format only to THF80@TaylorHaugen.org.
- 4. Include a maximum of **TWO** letters of recommendation from people other than relatives. One must be academically based from a school official: Teacher, Coach, Counselor, and/or Principal. The second letter must be a recommendation based on your moral character. Letters may not be from Taylor Haugen Foundation Board Members.
- 5. Optional Senior Resume may be submitted highlighting all Activities, Athletics and Awards.
- 6. Include Academic Record Report which must be completed and signed by the <u>Guidance</u> Department.
- 7. Statement of Understanding must have **actual signature** by the <u>Student</u> and <u>his/her Parent</u>, Guardian, or Sponsor.
- 8. Include answers to 4 short response areas (150 words or less each).
- 9. Include a personal 300 500 word essay on the following topic.
 - * Tell us about a life experience where you had difficulty and had to persevere and not give up.
- 10. Applicant <u>may</u> be contacted for an interview with the scholarship committee at a date to be determined.
